Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered service. IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR BIDDERS:

1. Bidders shall ensure that all documents related to pre-qualification (technical or commercial) and documents mentioned in the check list below are submitted at the first instance itself along with the original bids.

M/s. RCFL may summarily reject any bid not complying with this instruction. M/s. RCFL may not do any further correspondence to seek clarifications / shortfall documents.

2. Bidders are required to quote the Grand Total Price, inclusive of GST, for complete items or jobs. This price should be quoted after carefully considering and understanding the scope of work. Bidders must enter their prices in the designated field within the GeM portal. Please note that prices quoted elsewhere, such as in scanned documents, will be rejected.

3. Bidders are requested to upload the price breakup details for their lumpsum offer in the prescribed format, as attached, in the GeM bid document. Although the price break sheet is provided, it is indicative and will not be considered as a price bid for evaluation purposes.

4. For evaluation, only the prices entered in the GeM portal, which include the total value with GST, will be considered on an overall lowest basis. It is essential to ensure that the prices entered in the GeM portal match those provided in the price breakup sheet. Please note that the prices entered in the GeM portal will be final and binding.

5. Submission of offer against this Enquiry will essentially mean acceptance of terms & conditions mentioned in the enquiry in TOTO, including all the attached Annexures of Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC document. Any deviation shall lead to outright rejection of the offer.

7. Technical Pre-Qualification Criteria:

Bidders shall have experience of similar nature of jobs as per SOW Hydro jet cleaning of exchangers/equipments/vessels in any industry, during last 7years ending last day of month previous to the one in which application are invited.

8. **AWARD OF CONTRACT:** Contract shall be awarded on OVERALL **LOWEST TENDER BASIS** to Techno-commercially qualified bidder.

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Note :

- i. Bid Evaluation shall be carried out on Lumpsum Basis only.
- ii. Bidder shall quote Grand total Lumpsum price including all applicable taxes & duties for complete items/jobs
- iii. Bidders are requested to upload the price breakup details for their Lumpsum offer in the prescribed format, as attached, in the GeM bid document.
- iv. Bidder shall ensure that the quoted price is inclusive of GST and all other charges. Bidder shall be solely responsible for the price/s quoted by him and no communication in this regard shall be entertained after bid opening.

9. **CHARACTER AND ANTECEDENTS VERIFICATION (BEFORE ENGAGEMENT) OF CONTRACT WORKERS**

It is mandatory that character & antecedent's verification must be made of each & every contract labours prior to giving permission to enter inside RCF factory premises. Vendor must submit PVC of manpower to be deputed for site job. Entry permission on the basis of valid Passport is not allowed. Even passport holders have to apply for PVC. Without PVC, no entry permission shall be granted. A 15-day temporary permission can be granted on the basis of submission of a copy of on-line application form of PVC & its payment acknowledgement slip along with a copy of PAN / Aadhar card of that particular labour. Under special circumstances, a second 15-day temporary permission can be granted but this is at the sole discretion of RCF, as it is presumed that PVC is issued within 15 days from the date of on-line application. No further temporary permission shall be given after the 2nd time.

10. Declaration by Start-up bidders:

A) Start-up bidders must submit the following documents for both Category 1 and Category 2 mentioned below:

a) Start-Up registration certificate issued by the Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion (DIPP). Year of incorporation of Start-Up shall not be more than ten years from the due date of the tender.

11. Disputes and Arbitration Clause (between CPSEs inter-se and Government Departments/Organizations):

In the event of any dispute or difference relating to the interpretation and application of the provisions of commercial contract(s) between Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) / Port Trusts inter se and also between CPSEs and Government Departments/Organizations (excluding disputes relating to Railways, Income Tax, Customs & Excise Departments), such dispute or difference shall be taken up by either party for its resolution through Administrative Mechanism for Resolution of CPSEs Disputes (AMRCD) as mentioned in DP E OM No. 05/0003/2019-FTS-10937 dated 14th December, 2022 and the decision of AMRCD on the said dispute will be binding on both the parties.

- c) Details of social security entitlements.
- d) Engagement period and end of contract period.

16. **Payment Term :**

After successful completion of job, 100% payment shall be released on the 30th day from the date of submission of invoice to Contract Cell dept. along with all necessary documents as per WO.

In case of any discrepancy in the invoice, vendor has to resubmit the corrected invoice to Contract Cell Dept and 100% payment shall be released on 30th day from the date of resubmission of corrected invoice to Contract Cell Dept.

17. Early Payment Request and Interest Levy:

Should the Seller / Service Provider / Contractor requests early payment prior to the stipulated payment terms outlined in the Contract, such early payment, if agreed upon by RCF, shall be subject to an interest rate of twelve percent (12%) per annum on the amount paid early. This interest shall be calculated from the date of early payment until the date the payment would have ordinarily fallen due as per the Contract. RCF shall deduct such interest from the payment due to the Seller / Service Provider /Contractor

18. For New Vendor Registration :

In order to register the bidder as vendor in RCF's ERP (SAP) System and release of PO & Payment, bidder needs to submit the duly filled, signed and stamped copy of Vendor Form along with GST No, Bank Details, MSE Udyam Certificate.

In case of non-submission of above said documents, RCF shall register the bidder as vendor based on the details available on GeM Portal.

Bidder is solely responsible for the accuracy and completeness of information submitted and available on GeM Portal. RCF is not liable for any consequences arising from inaccuracies in this regard

19. Liquidated Damages (LD):

Sum equivalent to 0.5% (half) percent of the contract value of the delayed Services for each week of delay or part thereof until performance, subject to a maximum deduction of the 5% of the total contract value.

In case of inordinate delay (exceeding 25% of the completion period) this maximum deduction of LD shall be 10% of the executed value of the contract.

In the event of any changes to the LD clause in the GeM General Terms and Conditions (GTC), the prevailing GeM Clause shall apply and be explicitly stated in the GeM bid document.

Note:

- i. Inexcusable delays of more than one-fourth (25%) of the completion period specified in the contract shall be treated as inordinate delay(s).

- ii. Both Seller and Buyer agree that the percentages of LD are genuine pre-estimates of the loss/damage which the Procuring entity would have suffered on account of delay/breach on the part of the contractor and the said amount will be payable on demand without there being any proof of the actual loss or damage caused by such breach/delay

20. Penalty Clause late submission of bills:

The bill must be submitted complete in all respects i.e. supporting documents within 30 days from the date of completion of job. In case of delay in submission of bills (complete in all respects) beyond 30 days, vendor shall have to pay penalty at the rate of Rs. 100 per week or part thereof subject to maximum of 5% of invoice value shall be applicable.
